It is evident and folks are sharing that the Lord is leading us through the guidance and work of His Spirit during this intentional interim period. Below is a broad overview of what He has accomplished so far at TABC. In addition to this list, and of great significance, people are coming to the Lord, ministries are growing and those involved are unified in the mission of making disciples who make disciples for Christ.

April

- •First of the month, our pastor resigned.
- Deacons, leadership, and congregation prayed seeking the Lord's direction.
- Deacons and leadership decided to pursue the Transitional Interim
 Ministry approach (TIM).

May

- •TABC staff met and were introduced to TIM (May 20).
- •TABC Ministry leadership met and were introduced to TIM (May 22).

June

- •Churchwide meeting to introduce the congregation to TIM (June 5).
- •Congregation overwhelmingly affirmed TIM (June 30).

July

 Deacon's meetings to pray over selection process of transition team candidates.

August

- Deacons select candidates, contact candidates giving them time to prayerfully consider.
- •Congregation affirms the transition team members (August 25).

September

- •Transition team training (September 13-14).
- •Transition team's first meeting and began the Heritage Focus Point. (September 24)
- Began sharing regularly during Sunday morning services (September 29).

October

- •Began the Mission Focus Point (October 15).
- •Held the churchwide meeting to complete the Heritage questionnaire (October 20).

November

- •Recorded members video of their reflections at TABC (November 8-10).
- •Shared the results of the churchwide questionnaire (November 24).
- •Began the Leadership Focus Point (November 26).

December

 Continued the work on leadership seeking a Biblical model of leadership.

January

- Began showing member videos during the services.
- •TABC Mission Statement affirmed by the congregation (January 5).
- Continued focus on an 18-month vision statement for TABC (January 7). This statement will be presented soon.
- •New TABC logo affirmed by leadership (January 28).

February

- •Introduced the New Testament church Biblical model of leadership to the deacons (February 2).
- •New logo introduced to the congregation (February 16).

The TIM team, the deacons and your pastors are seeking the best Biblical model of leadership for Jesus Christ's church today. As we learn, grasp, and understand this model and how it will guide the ministry of TABC, that model will be shared with the congregation in a variety of formats and ways, giving you opportunity to also search the Scriptures and be led by the Spirit.

Recall in Exodus 32, the children of Israel, only some few months from living in captivity in Egypt, became impatient with Moses. In reality, their impatience was with God, as Moses had been gone for 40 days on top of Mt. Siani receiving God's leadership, guidance, and instruction for leading the people into the promised land. They resorted to the practices they had grown accustomed to from their history and past. They missed the new thing God had ready for them by resorting to their old traditions.

Let us learn from this passage and not become impatient with the Lord and His work as He desires to lead TABC in a new way for His glory and Kingdom purposes. Through this interim time, the only part of TABC that has been paused is the old methods which most folks would agree needed to be reworked. God is working at TABC and has a great plan for our ministry. Let us praise, honor, thank, and glorify Him for His work.

Dear TABC Family,

I have never been so at peace and so excited about a job in my life. Everyday I come on campus, gratitude fills my heart, mixed with a hopeful expectancy concerning what God is doing here. I would not trade this family of believers with anyone in the world because of the qualities of God's spirit that I see coming out of you all.

Of course this is not a job, it is a calling. I am on assignment here at TABC, and it's the same assignment that I had when I started here nearly 12 years ago. ALL of me must die on that cross before my new creation life can live in the authority of Jesus.

TABC, I can see the vision of what God is going to do here at this church. I get little glimpses of it; it's so beautiful and amaz-

ing. However, the enemy will do anything and everything to stop it. He doesn't play fair. It's the absolute opposite. The promised land is a life in union with God, building his kingdom on this earth. It's exactly like Joshua and Caleb and the Israelites. God said, "I give you the land of Canaan, now take it." Every inch of promised land was violently taken from the enemy. As they followed God's leadership, God's power led the way into giants and fortified cities. The Israelites had absolutely no business engaging. But, all things are possible through Christ Jesus who loves us.
